Flu vaccinations underway across Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent as NHS launches winter protection drive

All eligible people can now get their free flu and COVID-19 vaccinations. In the first week of the campaign 32,282 COVID vaccinations were given and, up to 7 October, 100,050 flu doses have been administered across SSOT. You can read more about the campaign in the media release.

Updated RSV eligibility guidelines

Winter vaccine resources

- New national assets for the flu and COVID-19 vaccine have been released for the
 <u>Public Winter Vaccinations Campaign</u>, including social media assets, posters, and
 <u>digital screens</u>. These include social media assets for 2-3 year olds and people with
 long term health conditions. Additional campaign resources are expected later this
 month.
- <u>Maternal vaccination assets for the 'Stay Strong, Get Vaccinated' campaign</u> are on the Campaign Resource Centre.
- NHS North East & North Cumbria Integrated Care Board have launched a 'Be Wise Immunise' flu campaign they have approved for these to be used by NHS organisations in Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent. Resources include videos, animations, stickers, and social media graphics for 2–3 year olds, school-aged children, and general flu messaging.

COVID-19 vaccine eligibility resources
